#### 2. BACKGROUND:

Kuruman (established in 1887) and surrounding towns, is located in the Northern Cape and falls under the John Taolo Gaetsewe District Municipality. Ga-Segonyana Local Municipality is responsible for local governance and performs the service delivery.

The current Sewage Treatment Works (STW) is located on the Western side of Kuruman, next to the Town. GPS reference; 27°26'23.5"S, 23°25'22.9"E and 1323m above sea level.



Figure 1.1: Kuruman Town and surroundings

The Kuruman WWTW receives sewage from Kuruman Town, the Industrial Area, Bankhara-Bodulong and Wrenchsville.

The Existing treatment infrastructure can handle a minimum of **4.0ML/day (ADWF)**, with expected **7.2 ML/day (PDWF)**.

There are currently 9 sewage pump stations, integrally forming part of the bulk sewage handling system.

#### 3. PROBLEM STATEMENT

With the growing need for services and the relocation of rural areas to the more developed areas, the Municipality of Ga-Segonyana need to roll out planning and implementation of a new Regional Wastewater Treatment Works to be placed strategically in order to cater for servicing Kuruman and the surrounding areas.

# 4. OBJECTIVE OF THE PLANNING, CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT WORKS AND INFRASTRUCTURE

Bidders are required to submit proposals in the form of a proposed master plan of how they intend to plan, cost and roll out the following scope of works required:

- a. The regional wastewater treatment works must be sized (and phased) according to spatial data available and include future growth estimates.
- b. The regional wastewater treatment works must also take into account future spatial development in terms of and related to Housing Development in and around the Kuruman Areas.
- c. Submissions must indicate the possible location of the new regional wastewater treatment works and probable maximum land space it will occupy.
- d. The main parameters for the design process will be a minimum of the following:
  - i. COD 900mg/L
  - ii. TKN 70mg/L
  - iii. P 18mg/L
  - iv. TSS 465mg/L

The alkalinity of the wastewater is currently unknown but assume for Bid purposes to be sufficient for biological wastewater treatment.

- e. The final effluent shall conform to General Standards according to DWS regulations.
- f. Detailed process flow diagram to be provided as well as schematic layout of the works.
- g. Allow for a temporary storage dam (sealed to DWS specifications) for excess stormwater flow and recycling of it to the works. Proposed capacity to be specified in Bid.
- h. Emergency standby generator to be housed in a building. Capacity of generator to be specified in the Bid as well as floor area of building to be provided.
- Security fencing (minimum 2.1m high) around the main operational area (including waste sludge management and dewatering areas) and 1.2m high cattle fence around emergency overflow ponds.
- j. The Bid shall include a detailed breakup of the annual cost of operating and maintaining the proposed works (allowing for a schedule of the electrical requirements of all proposed mechanical components).
- k. Office, ablution, and storage facilities to be provided as well as a small storeroom and shelter for the operator at the inlet works. Proposed floor areas of each to be specified in the Bid.
- I. Proposed waste sludge dewatering method to be specified in the bid and space required for it.
- m. The master plan should consider the current Wastewater Treatment works in planning and phasing of the proposal.
- n. The master plan must further include planned trunk sewer lines (estimated diameters) connecting the proposed (new) wastewater treatment works to all the areas as required.
- o. The project phases must clearly be indicated on the master plan and properly explained in the Bid presentation.
- p. Cost estimates must include all EIA and preparation of water use license.
- q. Allowance for gravel access road to the site as well as bulk electrical and water supplies.
- r. Proposed phasing must also allow for estimated costs for each phase.
- s. Must include cost for maintenance over a period of 5 years.
- t. The proposal must include referenced projects of the technical team in their CV's that is directly related to the scope and implementation requirements of this project.

#### 5. PROJECT DURATION

It is assumed that the proposals must include the master plan to be rolled out over 5 to 7 years.

#### 6. PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCIES AND EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

It is expected that the Engineers and Contractors will have the following qualifications:

- **6.1.** CIDB Grading designation 9CE
- 6.2. Professional Indemnity of R 10 million
- 6.3. B-BBEE level 2 or higher
- **6.4.** Bank Grading "C" or higher

#### 7. SCOPE OF WORKS

The successful bidder will be required to:

With reference to Section no 4 above, required bidders are to clearly indicate what is entailed in their scope of works.

#### 8. DELIVERABLES

Bidders are required to deliver the following:

- Draft technical Report including the following:
  - Design process and size of the total works
  - Clearly indicating implementation phasing
  - Drawings of layout and proposed location of the new works
  - Trunk sewer lines layout
  - Maintenance plan and costing for a period of 5 years.
  - Technical Teams experience in the design, planning construction and maintenance of Regional Wastewater Treatment Works.

#### 9.1. Data Ownership

All milestone products, developed for the purpose of this project, in addition to the final document and all associated map work shall remain the property of the Municipality.

- 1.5. The purchaser reserves the right to require of a bidder, either before a bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by the purchaser.

#### 2. **DEFINITIONS**

- 2.1 "all applicable taxes" includes value-added tax, pay as you earn, income tax, unemployment insurance fund contributions and skills development levies;
- 2.2 **"B-BBEE"** means broad-based black economic empowerment as defined in section 1 of the Broad -Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- 2.3 "B-BBEE status level of contributor" means the B-BBEE status received by a measured entity based on its overall performance using the relevant scorecard contained in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- 2.4 "bid" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by an organ of state for the provision of services, works or goods, through price quotations, advertised competitive bidding processes or proposals:
- 2.5 **"Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act"** means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003);
- 2.6 **"Comparative price"** means the price after the factors of a non-firm price and all unconditional discounts that can be utilized have been taken into consideration:
- 2.7 **"Consortium or joint venture"** means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skill and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract;
- 2.8 "Contract" means the agreement that results from the acceptance of a bid by an organ of state;
- 2.9 "EME" means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R5 million or less.
- 2.10 "Firm price" means the price that is only subject to adjustments in accordance with the actual increase or decrease resulting from the change, imposition, or abolition of customs or excise duty and any other duty, levy, or tax, which, in terms of the law or regulation, is binding on the contractor and demonstrably has an influence on the price of any supplies, or the rendering costs of any service, for the execution of the contract;
- 2.11 **"Functionality"** means the measurement according to predetermined norms, as set out in the bid documents, of a service or commodity that is designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account, among other factors, the quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and the technical capacity and ability of a bidder;
- 2.12 "Non-firm prices" means all prices other than "firm" prices;
- 2.13 "**Person**" includes a juristic person;
- 2.14 **"Rand value"** means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties;
  - 2.15 **"Sub-contract"** means the primary contractor's assigning, leasing, making out work to, or employing, another person to support such primary contractor in the execution of part of a project in terms of the contract;

- 2.16 **"Total revenue"** bears the same meaning assigned to this expression in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act and promulgated in the *Government Gazette* on 9 February 2007:

- In the event that two or more bids have scored equal total points, the successful bid must be the one scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.
- 3.5 However, when functionality is part of the evaluation process and two or more bids have scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the successful bid must be the one scoring the highest score for functionality.
- 3.6 Should two or more bids be equal in all respects, the award shall be decided by the drawing of lots.

#### 4. POINTS AWARDED FOR PRICE
