Ga-Segonyana Local Municipality has noted the call for national shutdown on Monday 20 March 2023 by the Economic Freedom Fighters (EFF).

Ga-Segonyana Local Municipality through the Office of the Municipal Manager Mr Martin Tsatsimpe informs the communities that the Ga-Segonyana Local Municipality offices will be operational from 07:30 until 16:30 as per office hours.

The constitution guarantees the right to protest peacefully and for protesters not to infringe on the rights of others. In South Africa it is a criminal offence to spread messages of fear, intimidation or inflammatory statements that could incite violence. We encourage our communities to report any form of criminality and intimidation to relevant law enforcement office.

It is our responsibility as the residents of Ga-Segonyana to protect our livelihood from any disorder, businesses and public infrastructures from any damage. The safety of our residents is our top priority hence the JTG Security Cluster and emergency services will be on duty should the need arise.

We urge all businesses to open without any intimidations or disruptions as the livelihoods of the people of Ga-Segonyana have to continue in these difficult economic conditions.
